The BIBB Internet portal for trainers, foraus.de, can now look back on ten years of existence. With more than 10,000 members every month, the Internet portal is the largest trainer community in Germany. The continuous growth in the number of members and in the number of times the foraus.de service is accessed every month shows how valuable the portal is for this key group of vocational education and training stakeholders.

Target group

Foraus.de offers its services primarily to full-time and part-time trainers, training specialists in enterprises, disseminators in the qualification of vocational education and training personnel and training officers in the field of initial and continuing in-company, inter-company and non-company training. The information and services of foraus.de are also intended for management personnel in the vocational education system, human resources and organisational development managers and all those involved in or interested in pedagogical processes and innovative developments in vocational education and training.

foraus.de has three key functions:

Informing:

Preparing up-to-date information on all aspects of vocational education and training and the field of activity of training personnel

Learning:

Providing online learning modules

Communicating:

Sharing experience with vocational training experts

Free membership in foraus.de provides trainers with numerous features for discussion, research and the exchange of experience. For example, online seminars on specific issues and problems that arise in connection with in-company training are offered at regular intervals and conducted in so-called virtual classrooms as moderated events.

Those visiting foraus.de will find the following functional zones on the website:

Home page

The home page not only features and links with topical issues and information, it also provides direct access to continuing education and training databases and new information services, such as "Qualification Digitally" and ELDOC.

News

In the comprehensive news area, the news is subdivided into five categories so that items can be found faster. Current events can be accessed via a separate menu item. An RSS function makes it possible to subscribe to news and events in the form of a newsletter.

Member forums

The foraus.de Community provides members with a modern and user-friendly platform for discussion with other trainers as well as experts in the field.

Online seminars

The online seminars offered at regular intervals are a further opportunity to share experiences. A new learning module is published in the learning centre for every online seminar, providing an introduction to the topic and references to further reading. The learning modules can be flipped through as in a magazine in so-called flipbooks or downloaded in PDF format. Modern digital learning methods, media and Web 2.0 functionalities are not only described in the learning centre but can be experienced and tried out in practice.

Focal topics

The editors keep adding new content to the "Topics" area. It started with the topics of vocational guidance/transition management and the new Ordinance on Trainer Aptitude (AEVO).

Info desk

In the "Service" area visitors will find current links and references to important training-related documents, law texts and sources, information on continuing and further training, learning media, incentive programmes and publications.

AF Shop

There is also a "AF Shop", where trainer support publications are arranged according to focal issues and can be ordered directly from the publishers.

The trainers' forum collaborates with a large number of online portals in Germany. The information thus made available is checked for their practical value in relation to initial and continuing in-

company training. Qualitatively relevant information is entered in the News area, put forward for discussion and in some cases adapted or edited for targeted application in vocational training practice. The foraus.de members are thus offered a comprehensive information service from one source.

The thematic forum www.qualifizierungdigital.de (Qualification Digitally), which is also new, uses a specified Internet presence to document the results of the current incentive schemes of the BMBF in the field of digital media and thus puts forward for discussion the associated prospects for initial and continuing vocational education and training. Pilot projects relevant to vocational education and training practice will be able to use this site at the same time as a marketplace for the application and transfer of their work. This is a direct contribution to the benefit realisation and targeted innovation transfer that the BMBF wishes to bring about through incentive measures.

All in all, with the online services of foraus.de the BIBB is making a concrete contribution to constant quality development and improvement of initial and continuing education and training practice by making specified information and continuing education opportunities available in particular to the responsible and central group of disseminators, the specialised training personnel.
